This week it's where to call if you have an accident; the bottom line being that you don't want to start searching for the number of the emergency department when you have had a nasty shock! Here is the local number for the school area, if you live further afield your hospital will be different:

(This is the hospital emergency department in to visit if it is an accident, but you are able to drive the patient. Ring before-hand and have the patients CPR number ready. With severe accidents always ring 112

If your child, or you becomes sick, and it is out of your local doctors surgery opening times (16:00 – 08:00) then ring this number: **38 69 38 69**. This takes you through to a central switchboard where you will be designated a local hospital to you, again...have the CPR number ready!

- If you happen to have an accident with your kids out of school hours in the playground, then please go to the Svanereden assistants and they will ring through to the hospital for you. Otherwise, these details are available on Birgitte's window.
